First of all, by definition, the word REALTOR® refers to a member of the National Association of REALTORS®. It's not the same thing as being a licensee, which just means that you hold a real estate license.

The word REALTOR® has only two syllables – REAL-TOR! It's not Real-a-tor. It's the same as Doc-tor, Law-yer – just two syllables - REAL-TOR!

When you use the term REALTOR®, you are telling everyone that you are a member of the REALTOR® organization.

As a REALTOR®, you are a member of three Associations – Local, State, and National.

We'll take a look at your local association first.



Each local board varies on the specific benefits they offer to their members, but one thing all of our local boards provide is an opportunity to network with your fellow members.


Many networking events are hosted by the Association for Agents, Affiliates, Local Politicians, and Business Leaders in our communities.

Some examples of these are Lunch and Learns, Meet and Greets, and monthly or quarterly General Membership Meetings as well as Conferences.



Many local boards provide some sort of education for their members.

Usually these education events help their members complete some of their required continuing education hours or provide training on specific topics required by the National Association, like Code of Ethics and Fair Housing.



Your Safety is one of the most important concerns of our associations.

Most local boards offer training on best practices and security measures to help protect you.

In the event you become aware of some sort of suspicious activity, notifying your Local Association will help communicate the possible danger to other REALTORS® and keep them safe.



Through your local boards, you have opportunities to serve your community. The Association helps get your foot in the door and gives you access to service opportunities.

Your local board may partner with a local food pantry, a school supply closet at your neighborhood school, shelters, and other community organizations.



As a REALTOR [®] you have the opportunity to serve ina Leadership position for your local board.

Service as a Board Officer


Through these leadership opportunities. You have an chance to both improve the association and grow your leadership skills.

The MS REALTORS® Institute is the Education Arm of the State Association. Pre License and Post Licensing Education is offered here, the GRI Designation, as well as many other designations are available;

Continuing Education to meet the MREC requirements are among the modules available in person and online.

Leading You Home is our pre-packaged Financial Education program available exclusively to Mississippi REALTORS[®]. It is designed for use in educating High School Students about preparing for the home buying process.

Our MARPAC Trustees work with Political Leaders to support initiatives that directly protect Property Ownership Rights and advance pro-business initiatives.




On the National level, NAR offers professional development opportunities through online courses and the Center for REALTOR® Development.
